Award and Scholarships: The MDCGC State Meeting and Education Committee's Awards and Scholarships Subcommittee supports & recognizes educational endeavors and/or members' efforts to improve and promote the profession of genetic counseling in MD and DC. The Subcommittee aims to provide funding to any combination of the following: prospective and/or current genetic counseling students, member-initiated research proposals, projects designed to facilitate genetic counselors' career development and visibility in the region, or recognition for outstanding members of the community. The Subcommittee will establish annual criteria for awards & scholarships distribution and work with the MDCGC Treasurer to determine available funding.

Justice, Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (JEDI): The MDCGC JEDI subcommittee will support the voices and feedback of diverse students and genetic counselors in the regional area by integrating efforts to improve justice, diversity, equity and inclusion in practice and within the community at large. The expectation of involvement is a monthly call to share ideas and discuss plans to address the goals of the subcommittee. _

Outreach: The Outreach Subcommittee will work towards establishing and maintaining contact with local schools and universities to promote awareness of the field of genetic counseling. This includes coordination of outreach events and facilitating contact between MDCGC membership and students interested in genetic counseling. The subcommittee will also be responsible for creating and maintaining recruitment materials for prospective genetic counseling students.
