

#### **STATE MEETING & EDUCATION COMMITTEE**


- In addition to planning next year's conference, the State

#### **PUBLIC POLICY COMMITTEE**

Members of our committee went to Annapolis on 2/26 to testify before the MD State Senate Health, Education & Environment Committee regarding SB 0763, and on 3/6 to testify before the MD House of Delegates' Health & Government Operations Committee regarding HB 1040. If passed, the cross-filed bills would grant licensure for certified genetic counselors in MD. SB 0763 passed unanimously in committee and was headed to the full Senate for a vote before the General Assembly closed due to COVID-19. We are very optimistic for the future, and ever thankful for our legislative sponsors, physician champions, and patient advocates who testified in support of licensing CGCs!
